

Instructions for Candidates

1. Read the instructions made available time to time at the website very carefully.
2. Entry to the examination center is subject to production of the admit card and your photo ID proof (aadhaar card / driver's license / voter's identity / passport / pan card) in original and one self-attested photocopy of the same. You are required to carry with you the admit card (with a color passport size photograph, identical to one uploaded in online application form, pasted on it), photo ID proof in original and its self attested photocopy to the examination center. You will not be allowed to appear for the examination in case you do not carry these documents.
3. Candidates are required to wear only surgical Mask all the time during Examination. Please check RSPCB website for sample photo. Any other type of mask will not be allowed inside the examination centre.
4. You will be permitted to appear for the examination only at the center allotted to you. You will NOT be permitted to appear for the examination at any other examination center.
5. You are required to report at the examination center at the scheduled reporting time, mandatorily. You will not be permitted to enter the examination center after the scheduled reporting time. You would not be allowed to leave examination hall before examination is finished.
6. You will not travel on the roof of trains, buses, etc. for reaching at the examination center and will maintain all requisite discipline.
7. RSPCB reserves all rights to verify your identity and genuineness by taking signature and photograph or by any other means.
8. You will not be allowed to eat or smoke in the examination hall.
9. You will not be allowed to carry any textual material (printed or written), bits of papers, calculators, slide rules, log tables, wrist watches, pager, mobile phone, electronic devices (blue tooth, earphones etc.), bags, books, water bottle, food packets or Ornaments or belongings or any other material inside the examination center.
10. RSPCB will not be responsible for any loss/damage/theft of your belongings.
11. Improper conduct and use of UNFAIR MEANS will entail expulsion from the examination, cancellation of candidature and penal action as per the Rules.
12. Your appearance in this examination is subject to condition that if any ineligibility is detected at any stage, your candidature is liable to be cancelled.
13. Preserve your Admit Card until completion of recruitment process.
14. Examination test comprises of **150** Multiple Choice Questions to be attempted in **180** minutes. There is negative marking for wrong answers. Each correct answer would get three marks and each wrong answer would deduct one mark. Zero mark would be given for no response.
15. Question paper and answer key will be uploaded on RSPCB website <http://environment.rajasthan.gov.in> by **Sunday, 28-February-2021**.
16. Grievances regarding question paper and answer key, if any, can be submitted to RSPCB in hard copy by hand by **Wednesday, 03-March-2021, 5:00 PM in requisite format along with required fee**. Detailed instruction will be available on RSPCB website. Grievances submitted by **EMAIL and by POST will not be entertained**.

17. Each complaint will be addressed as per clause below and revised answers keys would be published, if any. No more complaints on questions and answers would be entertained after the due date. Results based on revised answer keys, if any, would be published.
- a) If formation of question and its answer as per the answer key is found correct no further action would be taken on such questions. Candidate fee for question grievance would be forfeited in such cases.
 - b) If it is found that formation of question is correct but another answer as compared to the answer key is correct unambiguously then answer key would be updated and published and result would be calculated based on updated answer key for all the candidates.
 - c) In case it is found that formation of question is correct but two or more answers are simultaneously correct, all such answers would be considered as correct then answer key would be updated and published and result would be evaluated based on updated answer key.
 - d) If formation of question is wrong and/or none of the answer is correct than this would be published and all candidates including those who have not attempted it, would get correct marks for it.

For grievances leading to clause (b), (c) and (d) above, the grievance fee would be reimbursed to the candidate who has made that grievance.
